We have heard exciting stories how previous emphases have started churches, strengthened



churches, developed leaders, encouraged mission, and produced new community ministries. There is no doubt God has used WRBA churches to transform Waco, but there is still great opportunity in front of us.

As we hope for the future, the Association needs to be proactive about a number of things, starting with evangelism. While we have recently reaped the benefits of a few churches increasing their giving there is still a need. Chalk Bluff (where I pastor) has also agreed to increase giving to the association from two percent to three percent to further support the spiritual vitality of Waco, and I hope that you will consider doing the same for the sake of our future.


## FINANCIAL REPORT

2015 Budget: \$279,228.00

Budget needs as of Oct. 31: \$232,690.00

Budget receipts as of Oct. 31: \$206,946.55

The association is running a deficit of \$25,743.45 as of Oct. 31, and we anticipate an approximate \$30,000 deficit by the end of this year. We rely on consistent contributions from member churches to support the costs of running the association in order to better serve our churches and the community ministries.
