WRBA is a voluntary network of Baptist churches in Central Texas who have chosen to cooperate in order to extend and embody the good news of Jesus Christ.



"An association" may not be true for your church because as members of the association, your membership may not be connecting, meeting and working with any other churches. You are functioning by yourselves.


