1 in 5 practicing Christians are involved in discipleship

2 questions every church should be able to answer:

- 1. Do we have a comprehensive plan for making disciples?
- 2. Is our plan working?

Barriers to Discipleship

- "Busyness" of life
- Lack of commitment to discipleship
- Lack of church leadership with clear approach to growing disciples

Preferred Method of Discipleship (Barna 2015)


Practicing Christians

- ▶ 38% On my own
- ▶ 25% With a group
- ▶21% One-on-one
- ► 16% Mix of these

Senior Pastors

- ▶11% On one's own
- ► 52% With a group
- > 29% One-on-one
- ▶8% Large group

Defining What Is Discipleship

"Intentionally equipping believers through accountable relationships empowered by the Holy Spirit in order to replicate faithful followers of Christ." (Gallaty)



Desired Changes in How the Church Disciples

- ls not a program or ministry
- ls part of church's core identity
- Clear & intentional plan & approach
- Making Jesus' Final Words Our First Work (Gallaty)

Are Churches Assessing Their Discipleship Efforts?

When asked how they measure discipleship effectiveness? (Barna 2015)

- Many **describe** process & number of programs rather than **evaluate** results
- Many indicate effectiveness is not tracked or record only number involved

Fielder Church

- Inhale & Exhale the Gospel
- Make disciples who do the same

Intentional Accountable Measurable

Fielder D-Groups

- Missional Intentional lifestyle evangelism
- Accountable Covenant with clear expectations
- Communal Journey alongside one another
- Reproducible Measurable when mentee becomes mentor

Fielder D-Group Guidelines

- Pliability Jointly pliable for the Holy Spirit to shape us
- Confidentiality What is shared stays within the group
- Commitment
 - Pray for each other
 - Complete assigned readings
 - Respond to accountability questions
 - Make attending a priority

Fielder D-Groups

Foundation (FDG)

▶ To inhale & exhale the Gospel

Growth (GDG)

▶ To understand God's word & grow in love with Him

Leadership (LDG)

► To become missional leaders & develop radical love for imperfect people

Fielder D-Group Covenant

Prayer

Pray for 3 non-believers by name & group members' "one thing"

Hospitality

Invite a non-believer or friend into your home once a month

Fielder D-Group Covenant (cont)

Accountability

- List 5 most important discoveries
- ▶ Share your "one thing" you want to change in your life
- Truthfully respond to accountability questions

Reproducible

Commit to lead 3 new people through a D-Group

Commitment

- Commit to 6 months in a group
- Commit to 6 months *leading* a group

D-Group Basic Flow

Time Allotment	Agenda Item	Description
5 min	Hang out time	Time for people to reengage in relationship & trust
55 min	Accountability	Individual responses to accountability questions & praying for each person's area of need
50 min	Reading Discoveries	Time dialoguing about the 5 most important discoveries
10 min	One Thing	Share one thing you will change this week


