I love the sense of community at Willow Grove, and core Biblical teachings. I love that all who walk through the doors can sense the transformational power of Jesus Christ.'



THAT is "how the association works."



CHURCH HEALTH MINISTRY UPDATE - BY JEN MARTINSEN

I am excited to announce the launch of our pilot program called Faith Health Waco.

We are looking for a minimum of 15 churches to enter our pilot program. Please read below the characteristics, traits and responsibilities of a *Faith Health Liaison*. We are asking each participating church to make a commitment to start or to grow their health ministry and to select a trusting member of their congregation to act as a *Faith Health Liaison* for their church. Please be praying and thinking about the decision to enter the pilot and for the person who will be trained to lead this effort.

<u>Faith Health Liaison:</u> A church/faith community staff member or volunteer selected and supported by the church pastor/faith community leader who leads the Health Ministry within the church/congregation.

Traits and characteristics of a Faith Health Liaison include:

- -Well integrated into the life and culture of the congregation
- -Good communication and organizational skills
- -Understand the need for confidentiality
- -Ability to plan, keep records and documentation
- -Comfortable and compassionate with people in distress
- -Trusted by and accountable to the pastor/faith leader
- -Available for quarterly training
- -Able to develop on-going working relationships with the Faith Health Coordinators in the network (with Health Care Partners)

Responsibilities of a Faith Health Liaison in your church:

- -Leads and organizes the Health Ministry (volunteers) within their church
- -Recruits congregational members into the faith health network
- -Follows up with members after leaving the hospital
- -Provides support to members following an illness or treatment of a condition
- -Nurtures and aligns partnerships with community organizations
- -Provides information and referral services
- -Facilitates wellness activity and participation for members at church location or in the community (schedules health related classes & events)
- -Completes monthly report on wellness and Faith Health Waco activities within their church to Faith Health Director/Advisory Council
