

CHURCH SPOTLIGHT: SEVENTH & JAMES BAPTIST CHURCH

Pastor Erin Conaway and his wife, Carmen, were members at Seventh and James Baptist Church, back in with Waco ISD in providing school uniforms to their seminary days at Truett Seminary, on the Baylor University campus. He loved the worship and people, so when he received a call from the search committee, he was excited to begin a conversation. "Honestly though, I thought there wasn't much chance of mention, is their music ministry. "Our music it working out. Seventh has a history of fantastically intelligent and 'degreed' pastors; but I thought maybe I could be a good second-round candidate, someone they might consider after they'd gone through their 'A' list."

Through laughter and joy Pastor Erin and his family were called back to Seventh and James. The love of fellowship is only one of the many things he loves about Seventh and James. The congregation takes good care of one another, while growing and changing together as well. It's a community practicing a living faith. With a rich soil of intellectual thinkers, people are hungry to keep learning and growing. "I have fallen in love with the people of Seventh and James and I have the privilege of working with an outstandingly talented and caring staff."

With a wonderful congregation and staff, ministry is

strong and vibrant at Seventh and James. They partner students classified as 'homeless,' cook their own meals to supply for Meals on Wheels; and most recently, they have become an encouraging church for two CBF Field Personnel (missionaries) in Indonesia. Last to ministry is off-the-charts outstanding. We highly value music here at Seventh and it shows in our weekly worship, in our Children's Music Camp, our three hand-bell choirs, our youth and children's choirs, and all of the wildly talented musicians who share their gifts through instruments and voice. I could go on and on and on."

Pastor Erin Conaway finds Waco to be a healthy place to be a minister. He asks for prayer for wisdom, vibrancy, and also that their partnership with Second Missionary Baptist Church continues to bear fruit and grow in abundance. "Our annual combined worship service is one of the highlights of every year. Dr. Davis is a dear friend and colleague and we are both celebrating the way our congregations continue to move closer to one another and to work more closely together."
