RESTORATIVE JUSTICE & JAIL

Ella Mae Acker embraces her calling as a Christian. She fills her calendar each week by sharing the gospel at McLennan County Jail, Delaney House, and Jack Harwell Detention Center.

At the jail, she often teaches from John 1 and then John 3. She speaks with the women, as they sit behind bars, about being born again and having a new life in Christ.

"No matter what I am teaching, I always close with an appeal. I tell them in Romans 10:13, it says "Who so ever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." She then invites those who want to receive Christ as Savior to pray with her. Ella Mae also spends time volunteering with Light in the Gap (a ministry to women exiting prison) as a connector at the bus station. Even once this past year, her involvement with Jack Harwell and Light in the Gap crossed paths. An inmate who listened to Ella Mae's teaching from behind bars awhile back, remembered her familiar face the moment she saw her at the bus station.

"She threw her arms around me and called me by name - 'Oh Ella Mae! You were my Bible teacher at Jack Harwell.' I was the one who talked with her and had prayer with her that day at the bus station." "It is such a joy to see so many of these ladies I meet with come to know Christ. With these inmates, you will receive a joy that you cannot imagine."
