JOB DESCRIPTION AND QUALIFICATIONS

PURPOSE

The Director of Children's Ministries at Brazos Meadows Baptist Church will build age-appropriate, disciple-making disciples among our children, creating a dynamic, Christ-centered children's ministry that impacts the children and families of Brazos, providing a vision as to how we can better reach the children and families of our community.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Strong and growing personal commitment to Jesus evidenced by actions, attitudes, and relationships
- A genuine love for children; able to connect and relate exceptionally well to children and parents
- Passion for ministry to children and seeing both parents and children grow in their faith
- Highly relational, personable, with outstanding communication skills
- ♦ Strong leadership, administrative, and organizational skills
- High work ethic; team player
- ♣ Ability to enable, motivate, empower, and support volunteers and coworkers to effectively carry out the work of the children's ministry
- Prelate well to and maintain motivating relationships with children, parents, teachers, and leaders
- Possess the ability to use appropriate judgment, discretion, sensitivity, and confidentiality
- Preliable, trustworthy, self-starter, and excellent at following through on details
- ₱ Must have a strong desire to share the life of Jesus with children and see them become fully devoted followers of Christ

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

(we recognize that in a part-time position, ministry is done as time allows)

Be the "face" of the children's ministry to the church

- ⊕ Be the advocate, ambassador, and champion to the church on behalf of the children's ministry (birth-6th grade); communicate exceptionally well with parents and church frequently through various mediums verbal, print, digital, social media, etc.
- → Work with other ministerial and support staff to accomplish church objectives.

Equipping

- Recruit, equip, encourage, and train potential leaders and volunteers who are willing and enthusiastic to serve Jesus by serving children.
- Implement appropriate discipline models with all volunteers that are clear and exact (training as often as is necessary). Inform parents of these models so they know the behavior expectations.
- Oversee a New Christian Class for children who are ready to or have made professions of faith.
- ♣ Understand and teach the spiritual and developmental needs of children, including those with special needs, to volunteers.

Pastor to Parents

- Pastor families with children, including training, relationship building, and counseling, so as to help families spiritually equip their children.
- Follow up weekly with visitors, as well as members who have not attended recently. Encourage teachers to do the same.

Administration

- ₱ Follow the children's ministry vision and purpose. Evaluate programs, events, and personnel to achieve the goals of the children's ministry and to ensure theological soundness.
- Assess, recommend, purchase, or prepare and implement exciting, Bible-based, age-appropriate curriculum for each program and each age level; provide teachers and workers with the tools/supplies needed to effectively teach and lead programs.
- → Oversee scheduling, coordinating, and recruiting of childcare workers for weekly ministries and special events, volunteer or paid. Hire, train, and oversee all paid nursery workers.
- Prepare the annual preschool and children's ministry budgets; keep the children's ministry portion of website up to date and inviting; make effective use of social media.
- ☼ Coordinate all aspects of children's ministry events such as summer camps, special events, and annual events for kids and their families.
- Maintain proper safety and security procedures for the children's ministry; including criminal background checks for volunteers and paid workers, training on child abuse and protection, and other procedures to ensure the safety and security of children in this ministry.
- ₱ Manage children's classrooms (coordinating with PDO).

Outreach

- ♣ Be personally involved in BMBC's community outreach, and lead children to do so.
- ₱ Function as our liaison to Castleman Creek Elementary (working alongside Gwen Tenberg), including developing, implementing, and promoting participation in CCE's Buddy Program.
